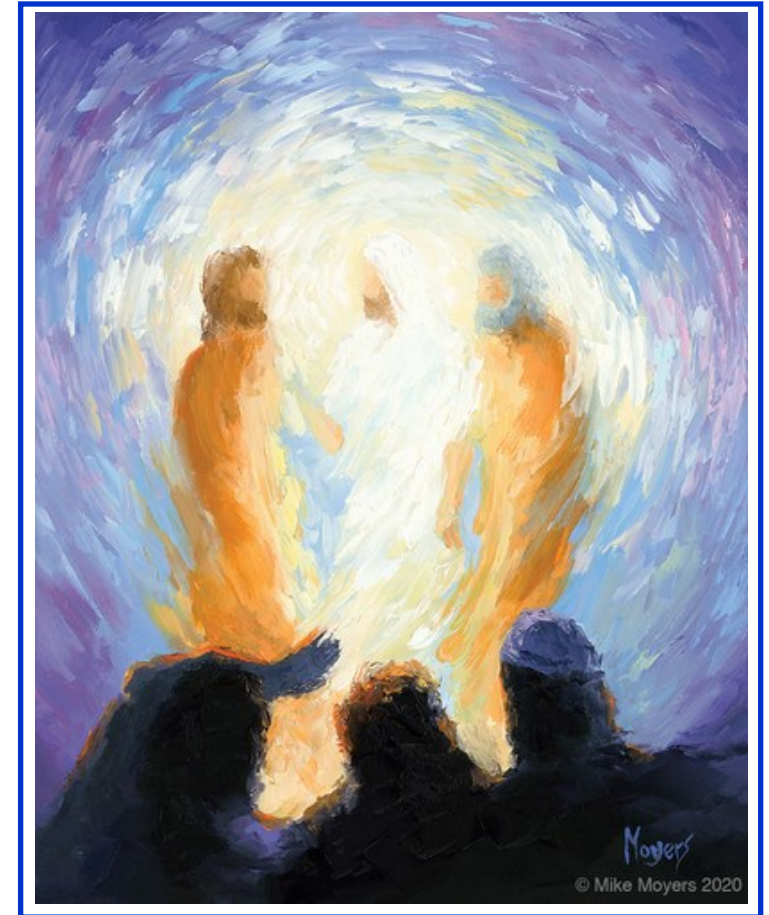

SHIRLEY FRANCIS



Shirley was born and brought up in South Africa during the Apartheid era. When she finished her qualifications as a teacher she followed her boyfriend to London where she got married and lived for just over 3 years. Not able to find a teaching job there she worked at the South African Embassy. Then in 1981 she and her husband moved to Australia. Tom Price was the first port of call. Quite a culture shock, London to Tom Price but a pleasant one. With Roy, her husband working in mining they moved around quite a bit. Tom Price, Karratha, Capel, Luina (Tasmania), Waratah (Tasmania), Sydney, Cue and Perth where they finally settled while Roy flew in and out. During that time they had two children and 5 grandchildren. 2014 led to a change in her life as a lifelong battle began. Her faith has played a large part in who she is and has led to her becoming a lay preacher.
