Distribution of Eucharist

The Diocese has now changed the rules of how the Eucharistic elements can be distributed. Because of the Covid epidemic the safest way of distribution was to suspend intinction (dipping) the wafer in the common chalice and for everyone to receive the wafer and partake of the wine from the common chalice. It has now been decided to allow intinction (dipping) from a smaller chalice which will be administered by the presiding priest. The priest will dip the wafer in the smaller chalice and present it to the communicant.

If you wish to receive communion by intinction please make it known by holding out one hand to receive, and the other hand, held up palm out by your shoulder.
