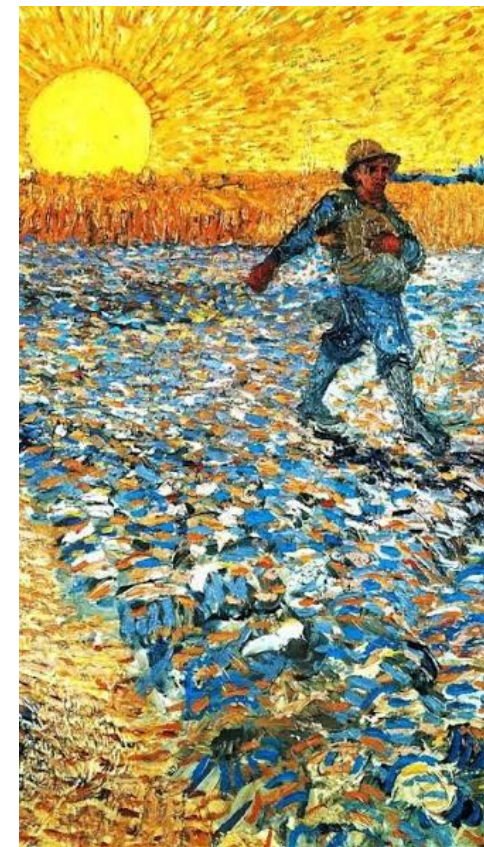

Prayer for Peace

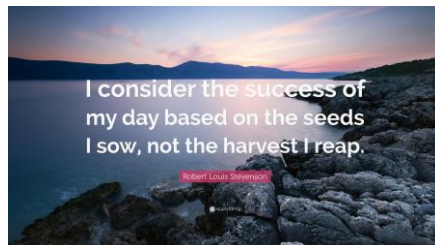

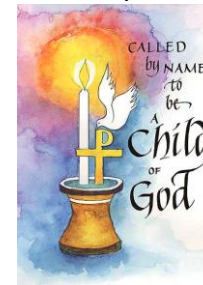
Preparation for Baptism and/or Confirmation
